

## TRAINER PORTFOLIO MANAGER



### JOB DESCRIPTION

A Training Portfolio Manager in an aviation training center is responsible for overseeing and coordinating a collection of training programs related to aviation.

This role combines strategic planning, educational oversight, and operational management.

### DAILY ROUTINE

For ongoing courses, the trainer introduces the session, supports the main trainer, gathers participant feedback, and debriefs to plan any improvements.

For other courses, they handle promotion, monitor enrolments, decide on go/no-go, initiate implementation, and request content updates when needed.

At the portfolio level, they review competitor offerings, shape content strategy, recruit trainers, and stay current on industry developments and regulations.

### IMPACT ON PRIVATE LIFE

The role follows standard office hours with minimal urgent situations. Travel requirements are limited and only occasional.

## SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

This position requires someone with strong project management skills, deep knowledge of aviation training requirements, and the ability to balance educational quality with operational efficiency.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

A candidate for the role of trainer of portfolio managers in areas such as safety, regulation, and human factors must have a solid background in aviation, along with proven experience in delivering training and strong management capabilities. In addition to these core requirements, it is advantageous for the candidate to have expertise in at least one technical domain relevant to the role, such as safety, security, or human factors, to provide deeper insight and credibility in their training delivery.
